

Change License/Update Security Code

<i>Speech</i>	<i>Cursor Actions</i>
Sumac trial databases do not require security codes.	
But all others, from Bronze to Platinum, do.	Show slide.
<p>The security code incorporates information about your organization name and office, the maximum number of contacts allowed in your database, the expiry date for your Sumac license, and which optional modules are included with your installation of Sumac.</p> <p>You may need to alter this security code if any of these items change.</p>	Show slide.
<p>For example, if you license additional Sumac modules, Sumac staff provide you with a new security code which enables the additional features in your database.</p> <p>Also, each year, as you renewed your Sumac license, you are automatically sent a new security code to extend the expiry date.</p>	Show slide.
To enter a new security code, click Utilities, Sumac Administration, and Change License.	Show Console. Expand Utilities. Expand Sumac Administration. Click Change License.
Sumac asks you to enter the security code for your organization.	Enter sample security code.
Click OK.	Click OK.
That updates your Sumac license to accommodate any changes to your installation of Sumac.
